

**Welcome to the 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Waikato Veteran Golf Association's Festival of Golf supporting the Waikato Rescue Helicopter Service.**

Cards for each team will be pre-printed to be collected prior to each round, by the team captain. Captains should advise of any team changes for that day's play. Daily reserves will print their own cards at the starter's office or Pro Shop prior to teeing off.

Team Captains are responsible for registering their team's scores. All four stableford scores on each hole count towards a cumulative total over the four rounds played. Team Captains should ensure all four cards are kept together when handing cards to club officials at the completion of each round.

There will be a **compulsory** refreshment stop of approx. 8 minutes at the halfway point to accommodate a full field of 2 tee starts.

*It would be appreciated if Captains could nominate intended reserves (and their DotGolf numbers) for Pirongia, Te Awamutu, and Cambridge when they report at Morrinsville on Monday to the Tournament Convenors.*

Disputes must be registered with club officials within 15 minutes of the completion of a round.

In the event of teams being tied after four rounds a chip and/or putt-off will be organised to determine the winning team and subsequent placings.

Raffles and any Twos competitions will be at each hosting club's discretion.

This is a fun Tournament, primally to raise funds for the Waikato Rescue Helicopter Service, and for players to enjoy the occasion. This is the main focus. However, as there are prizes for teams, the Association expects that teams play to the rules and reflect proper sportsmanship during their rounds.
